Minister Tracy M. Roddy

Preacher and Teacher of the Gospel of the Kingdom of God



Minister Tracy M. Roddy is a preacher and teacher of the Gospel of the Kingdom of God. He is a servant-leader who believes in the power, presence, and purpose of the Holy Spirit working in and through God's people. His ministry is centered on helping others recognize their identity, walk in God-given authority, fulfill their Kingdom purpose, and draw closer to the King.

Called by God to minister His Word more than twenty years ago, Minister Roddy has served in several areas of leadership, including youth ministry, outreach, and Sunday school instruction. He was also blessed to serve

for five years as Senior Pastor of New Life Faith Baptist Church, a church plant established to minister to individuals and families through the transforming truth of God's Word.

A lifelong student of Scripture, Minister Roddy continually seeks the knowledge, wisdom, and understanding that come from God rather than relying solely upon human learning. In 2018, he earned a Bachelor's degree in Biblical Studies from Colorado Christian University. He has also earned certifications in Pastoral Counseling and Chaplaincy, strengthening his ability to serve with compassion, spiritual discernment, and sound biblical guidance.

As an author, Minister Roddy has created several Kingdom-centered writings designed to inform, challenge, equip, and transform God's people. Among these works is *Close to the King: Kingdom Discipleship*, a training resource that helps disciples move beyond religious routine and develop a genuine relationship with Jesus Christ as King.

Yet he does not consider his education, leadership experience, ministry positions, or published writings to be his greatest accomplishment. His greatest testimony is recognizing that he was a broken man in need of a Savior. He came to sincere repentance, asked God to forgive his sins, and surrendered his life to the One to whom it had always belonged.

Today, Minister Tracy M. Roddy boldly declares that he is saved, sanctified, and committed to serving the Kingdom of God. Jesus Christ is his Savior, his Lord, his King, and the rightful ruler of his life.
